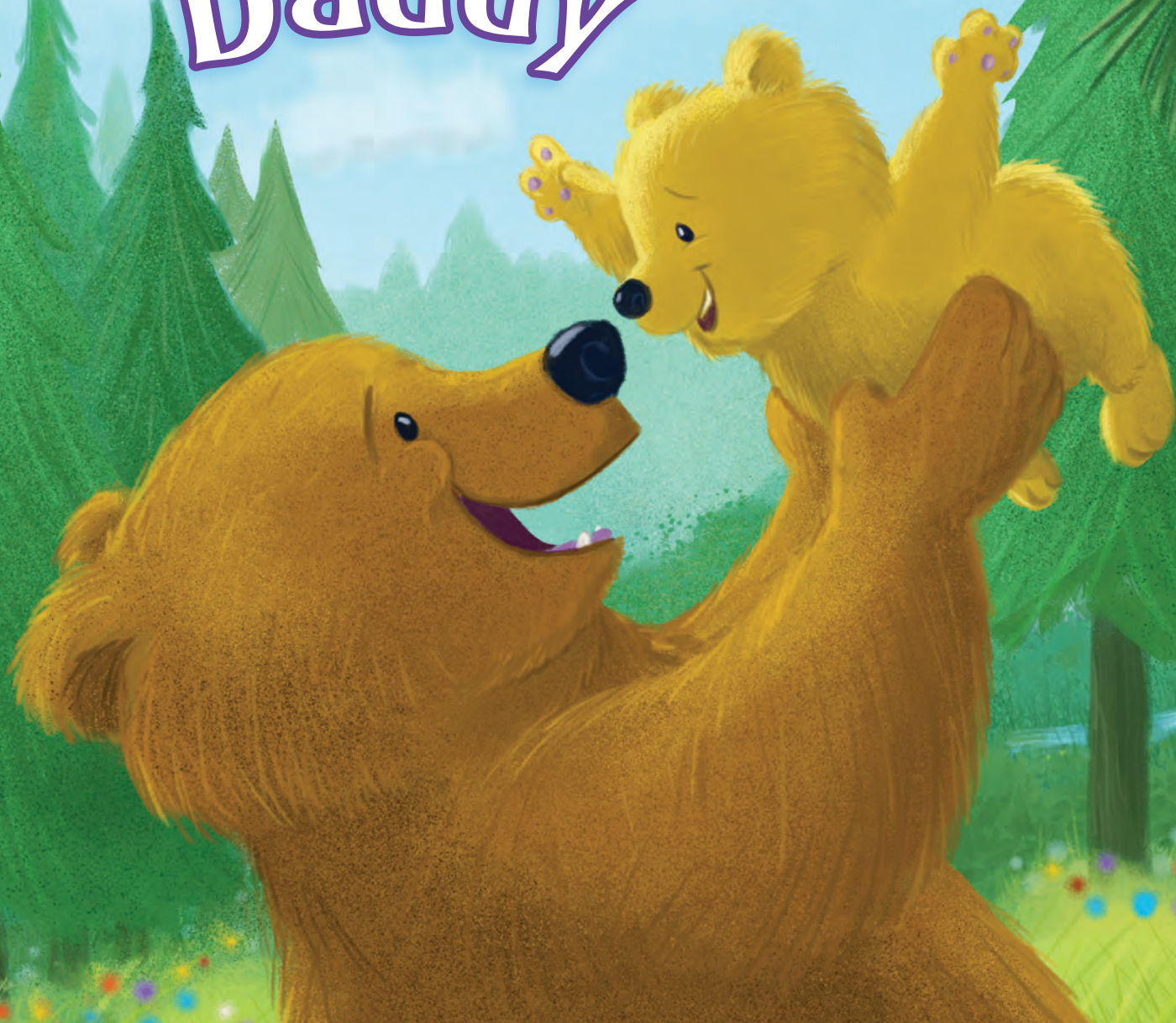


God Gave Me Daddy

Like raking leaves and fixing doors.

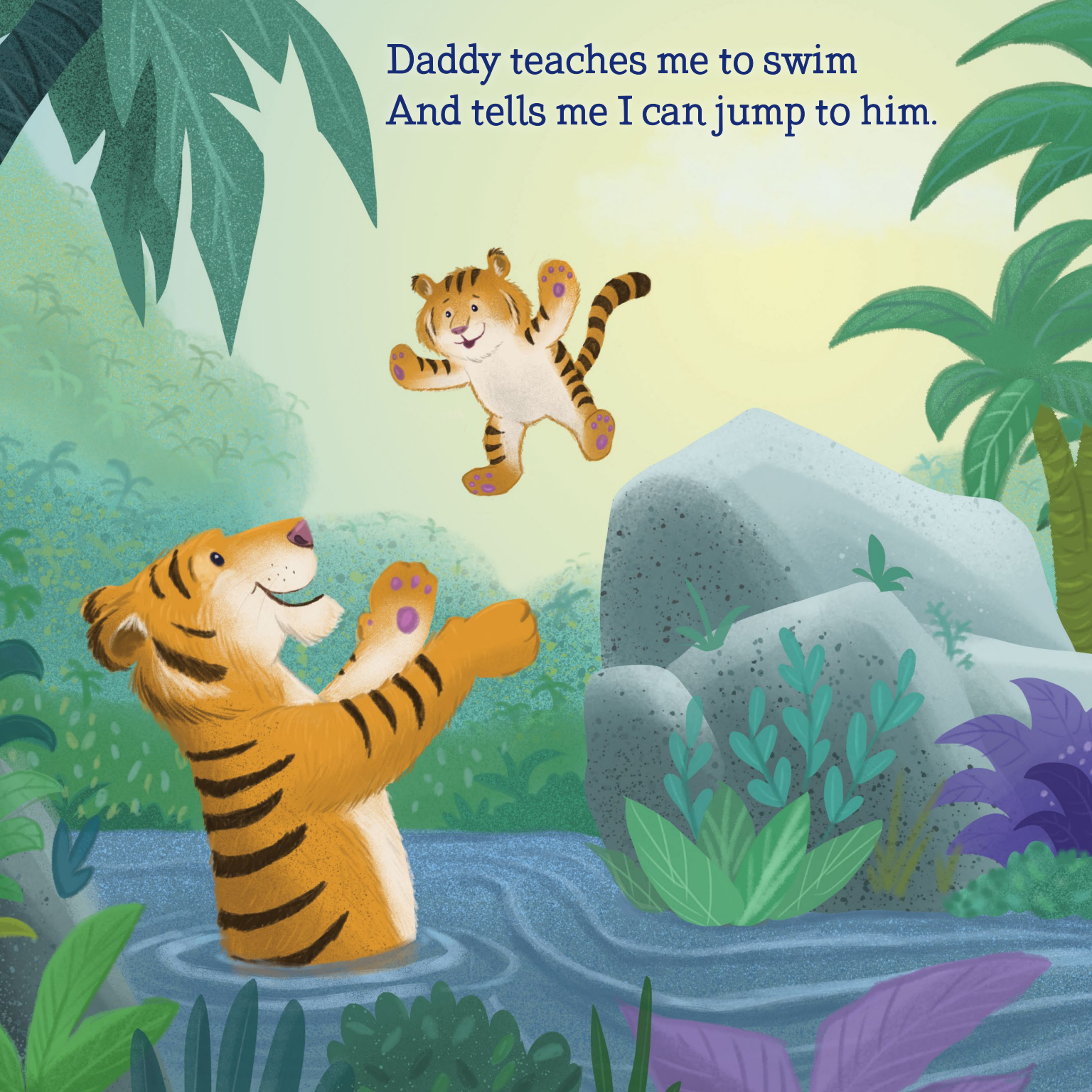
We work together!
