Jesus encouraged us to pray and promises to answer the prayers of His children, when we pray according to the plans God has for us, and for others.

Prayer for us is very easy. We simply talk to God. The reason it is so straightforward for us is that it was costly for God. He paid the greatest price of all so that we can pray to Him ... anytime ... anywhere ... and about anything.

When Jesus was crucified He actually carried upon Himself all the wrong of which we are guilty, so that if we believe on Him we can be forgiven and come to know God in a personal way. Here are some prayers you may find helpful to pray and personalise for your own situation.

Words that are in italics are there so that they can be adjusted if you are praying for someone else.

A prayer of thanksgiving and praise

I worship You that You are God and that there is no one else like You.

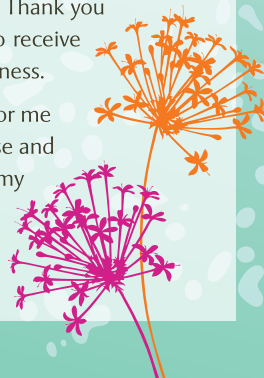

For times of sickness or trouble

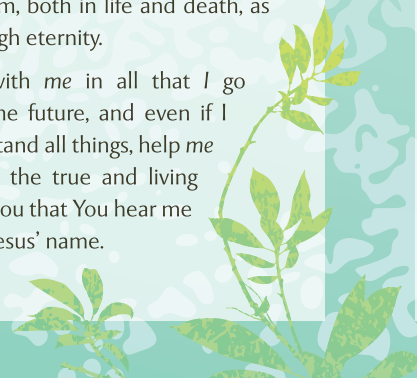
Dear Gracious God,
